
Dear Mr. Hoidal:

In response to the *Notice of Probable Violation and Proposed Compliance Order*, (Reference CPF 5-2008-5006), received from your office dated March 14, 2008, Idaho Pipeline Corporation (IDPC) provides the following:

- IDPC submitted the required geospatial data to the National Pipeline Mapping System April 17, 2008 and have been assigned tracking number (NPMS ID) NR0814-0001 (See attached email response from NPMS).
- Analysis (overlay) of our pipeline location relative to the High Consequence Area (HCA) as determined by the NPMS indicates that the IDPC pipeline could possibly affect a HCA under a worst-case discharge. (See attached overlay).

Please note that you will not be able to view the status of your submission until it has been processed up to the Quality Control stage.

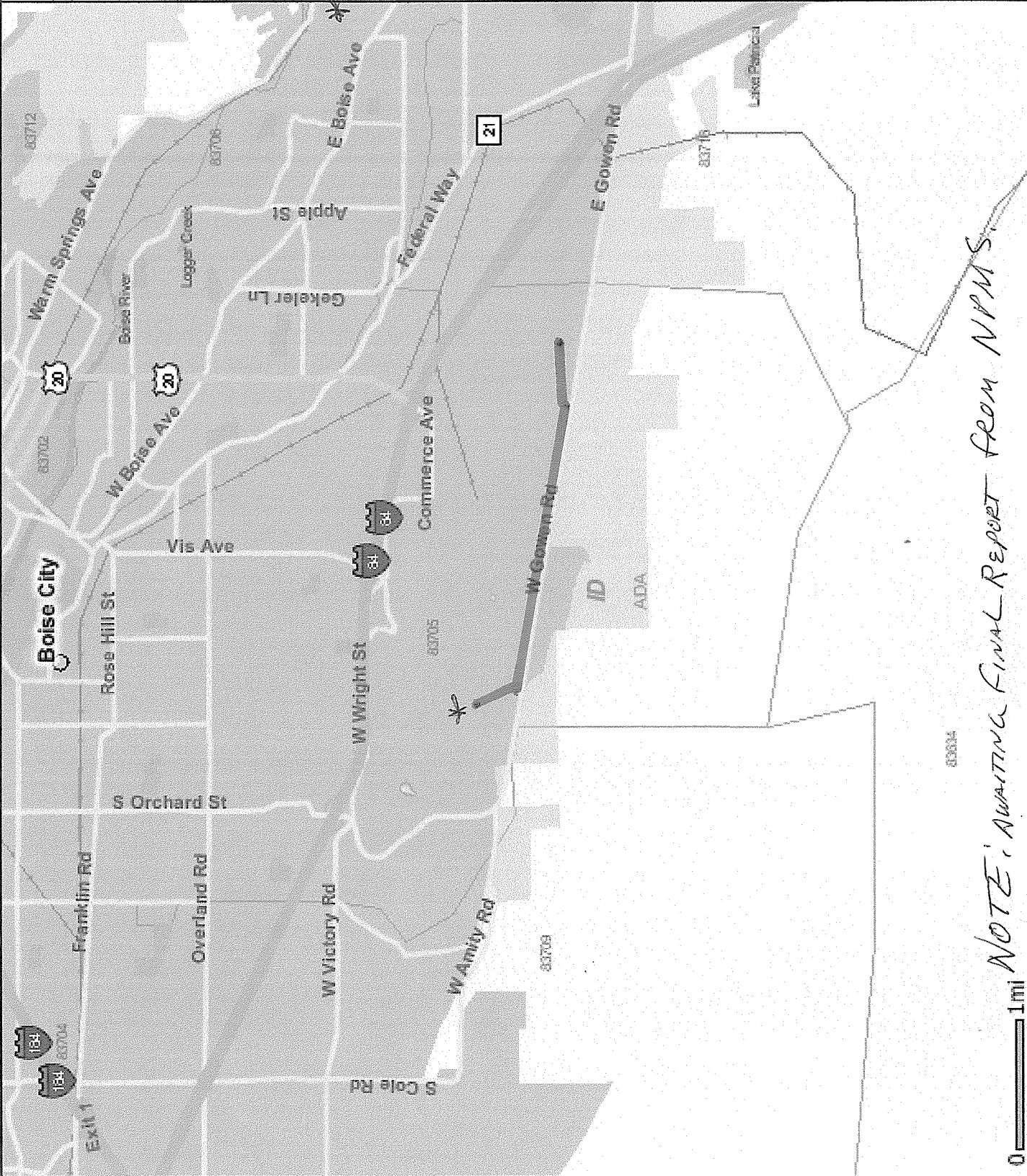
